

Technical Requirements

1. The full text of the papers should not be more than 10 pages /18000 signs/, incl. figures and tables.
2. The material should be written and ready for printing on **WinWord, AdobePageMaker or QuarkXPress**. For the main text use font **Times New Roman** – Size 10 pt., Normal, single line spacing.
3. The diagrams and tables should be in format cdr or esp /text format/.
4. Maximum print margin for diagrams and tables – base 122 mm, height 178 mm.
5. The papers should be formatted in the following way:
6. **heading** - in capital letters, 12 pt., (Center, Bold), blank line,
7. **heading in English** - in capital letters, 12 pt., (Center, Bold), blank line,
8. **the name of the authors** - (Center, Bold), 10 pt., blank line,
9. **annotation** - up to 8 lines and key words in Bulgarian and English (Italic), 2 blank lines;
10. The text of the paper – the paper should have an introduction, main part, results, conclusions, literature; the figures and tables should be in the text.
11. The information about the authors – names, rank, degree, organization (university), telephone, fax number, e-mail, should be under the heading “For Contacts”
