

**Project name** Inspire students entrepreneurial thinking to drive discovery, creativity and innovation (INSPIRE)

**Description** INSPIRE focuses on the development of entrepreneurial thinking to drive discovery, creativity, and innovation primarily for HE students but also for VET and aims to train 120 HE and VET students that will be eligible for certification, according to the standards of 17024, as well as recognition of their knowledge, via ECTS.



INSPIRE is based on the EntreComp framework that has been developed and published on behalf of DG Employment, Social Affairs, and Inclusion of the EC. By producing a common definition of what entrepreneurship as a competence is, the EntreComp aims to foster entrepreneurial learning.

INSPIRE seeks to develop HE and VET students based on the EntreComp framework, through the application of a systematic methodology using student centered innovative approaches and to validate the competences that the VET and HE students develop via the development of a Certification Scheme, according to ISO requirements, and the assignment of ECTS points for HE students.

The main project activities are as follows:

- Development of INSPIRE Training Pathways (EQF 5 and EQF 6);
- Development of Training Needs Analysis Tools (TNA) and Training materials;
- Development of INSPIRE Certification Scheme;
- Design and establishment of multilingual online open e-learning / networking space;
- Producing INSPIRE Guide book.
